Our first stop will be the Ben Maltz Gallery, Otis College of Art and Design, to see *Doin' It in Public: Feminism and Art at the Woman's Building*. Meg Linton, Director of Galleries and Exhibitions, will lead us through the exhibition, which aims to recapture the significant impact the Woman's Building had on the feminist art movement in Southern California.

We continue north on the 405 to The Getty Center, where we will be met at noon by an educator for a tour of *Pacific Standard Time: Cross Currents in L.A. Painting and Sculpture 1950-1970*, which features works by nearly 50 artists, on loan from preeminent national and international collections, allowing visitors to get a sense of their distinctiveness as well as their place within broader historical movements.
