The Contemporary Collectors will visit three fabulous private collections in the stunning Hancock Park homes of these friends who live just a stone's throw from one another.

We will begin at Judith and Alex Angerman's beautiful, vintage Spanish-Revival showplace filled with a wide-ranging collection of modern and contemporary works by such noted artists as Alex Katz, Vik Muniz, Ron Kitaj, John Chamberlain, Viola Frey, Alison Saar, Paul Wonner, And, of course, remarkable paintings and collages by Judith herself, who brings the artist's point of view to collecting.

Just down the street, we will be bowled over by Sirje and Michael Gold's cutting-edge assemblage of works that reflect their focus on a triangle of art-rich cities: Los Angeles, New York and Miami. As Michael says, this is not a collection of "the usual suspects." They have just curated *Discovered/Undiscovered* at the University Art Museum, CSULB, and that project, as well as their home, reflects their interest in such artists as John Baldessari, Daniel Wheeler, Steve Roden, Tony de los Reyes, Martin Kersels, Kim Dingle and Monique Prieto.

After a yummy West Hollywood lunch at a trend-setting bistro, we'll return to McCadden Place for extraordinary and gorgeously presented treasures, plus dessert, with Margery and Maury Katz. Their collection of American Modernism (1900-1945) and the circle of Alfred Stieglitz – acknowledged as one of the two or three finest in America – includes major works by the most influential artists of the early 20th century. Maury will share his huge knowledge of the period with us while Margery, a renown teaching chef, creates gourmet goodies to cap our beautiful day. They were kind enough to arrange our McCadden Place festival for us, for which we are most grateful.
